## **Assessment Methods**

- ✓ Quizzes (20%) – Two quizzes of 10% each will assess student's understanding of key business concepts.
- Group Project / Case Study (25%) – Collaborative problem-solving with real-world applications.
- ✓ Final Examination (30%) – Comprehensive exam covering all modules and topics.
- ✓ Individual Assignment (15%) – Research-based paper on a global business topic.
- ✓ Class Participation and Discussions (10%) – Active participation in lectures, seminars, and case discussions.



## Admission procedures and requirements

- ✓ Eligibility: Students must be enrolled in a Muthoot Business School Partner University or college and meet the required academic qualifications.
- ✓ Application Form: Complete application form and submit it along with the required documents (transcript, passport copy, personal statement, and proof of English proficiency) to their university assigned coordinator.
- ✓ Visa and Travel Arrangements: Once accepted, students will receive guidance on visa procedures, travel arrangements, and orientation schedules.
- ✓ Confirmation: Upon successful completion of the application process, students will receive a formal offer and details on the upcoming semester's start date.
- ✓ Selection Process: Applications will be reviewed, and selected candidates will be invited for an interview or further assessments (if necessary).
